The Black Canadian Scholarship Fund (BCSF) was founded on May 01<sup>st</sup>, 1996 when Dr. Horace Alexis, a family physician, donated the initial capital of \$5,000. Together with Pat Holas, he signed an agreement with the Ottawa Community Foundation and started the Donors Committee.
